How to Enrol

To enrol your child, please:

- 1. Go to our website www.mangodance.com.au

- Mango has strict policy of pre-payment before commencement of classes.
- Please register your child 1 week prior to arrival so that we may process your registration and inform the teacher of your arrival.

Uniforms

We do not have a set uniform. We do ask the following:

- Black leggings (girls), Grey shorts or black tracksuit pants (boys)
- Black Jazz shoes or bare feet
- Hair out of the Face tide up

Parent observation:



- a. It is very distracting for your child as they keep looking over to you .
- b. It is very distracting for the teacher to have the child constantly looking over or running over to their parent.
- c. It is also very distracting for the teacher to have the parent speak to the child and yell out instructions to their child during the class.
- d. Children learn better and are more able to achieve a level of independence and confidence without parents watching them in the class.
- 2. You are welcome to come and watch the last 5-10 minutes of the class to see how your little one is doing.
- 3. If your child is in the tiny tots class and is having separation issues, then it is ok for to stay for the class or how long you feel is necessary. However, just like daycare and playschool, it is best to have short quick goodbyes and leave your child once they are used to their environment.











Parents:

- 1. Please bring your child into the venue (do not drop out the front). Mango Dance Studio does not accept responsibility for your child around or outside the premises.
- 2. Please be sure to take your child to the toilet before the class commences.
- 3. Please be sure to send your child to class with a water bottle.
- 4. Please make sure to pick your child up from the venue, not outside the venue.
